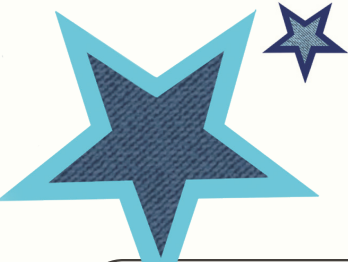


denim through the decades
